BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 144
Series of 2012

SUBJECT: GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM SPECIFIC MEASURES OF REGULATORY CONTROL REQUIREMENTS TO CERTAIN FINISHED PRODUCTS OF SCAD SERVICE(S), PTE., LTD.

WHEREAS, under Section 81 (b) and (r) of Article IX of RA 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, the Board issued Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003 which provides for the “Comprehensive Guidelines on Importation, Distribution, Manufacture, Prescription, Dispensing and Sale of, and Other Lawful Acts in Connection with any Dangerous Drugs, Controlled Precursors and Essential Chemicals and other Similar or Analogous Substances”;

WHEREAS, SCAD SERVICE(S), PTE., LTD. with business address at Block 23, Phase 4, Expansion, Cavite Economic Zone Authority, Rosario, Cavite, Philippines is seeking exemption from regulatory measures of the following products containing controlled chemicals listed hereunder:

1. SE Conc Stain Red – 15-20% MEK
2. SE Conc Stain Black – 15-20% MEK
3. SE Conc Stain Yellow-3 – 15-20% MEK
4. CWH-80-PH-B 1 – 15-20% MEK

WHEREAS, Section 4(2-c, d, e & f), Article II of the same Regulation also provides that the Board may exempt from specific measures of regulatory control requirements any preparation when the Table II chemical is a normal ingredient in consumer goods or finished products; or liquid chemical mixture containing less than 30% by weight of the Table II chemical; or solid, semisolid and highly viscous chemical mixture containing Table II chemical; or when the Board is satisfied that the mixture is formulated in such a way that the controlled chemical cannot be easily used for the illicit manufacture of a dangerous drug and that the controlled chemical or chemicals contained in the mixture cannot be readily recovered;

WHEREAS, to assist the Board in evaluating requests for exemption, it promulgated Board Resolution No.1 Series of 2008 entitled “**Creating a Technical Working Group (TWG) to assist the Board in considering request of Manufacturers and Importers of finished products from specific measures of regulatory control requirements**”;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the DDB Technical Working Group (TWG) that **SCAD Service(s), Pte., Ltd.** was established on October 1995 and started its business on 26 May 1996. Its main line is wooden products which are exported outside the country and sold in Asia. The company is engaged in the manufacture of various housing fixtures such as window frames, door frames, stairs and handrails, cupboards, kitchen cabinets, closets and others. **The company is duly registered with PDEA and handler of P5IM-01667001-R0343 dated 06 July 2012 and valid until 22 July 2013;**

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and evaluation, the TWG decided to recommend to the Board the exemption of **SCAD SERVICES, PTE., LTD.** finished product containing controlled chemical below the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-2(d, e & f);

WHEREAS, after satisfying the requirements stipulated under the above mentioned regulations, **SCAD SERVICES, PTE., LTD.** above mentioned product is **no longer covered by the provisions of Section 10 (Application for import, export or transit permits), and Section 11 (Grant of import, export or transit permits), of B.R. No.3, S. 2003.**

WHEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a. TO GRANT EXEMPTION** and the issuance of a Certificate of Exemption, which **shall be valid for one (1) year** unless revoked, to **SCAD SERVICE(S) Pte. Ltd.**, the product containing controlled chemical below the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-2(d & f):
- b. That the above cited exemptions shall still be subject to the following conditions:**
 - (1) The SCAD Service(s) Pte., Ltd. shall secure a license from PDEA and comply with the reporting requirements as provided for in Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003;
 - (2) The Board shall strictly monitor subject finished product from their importation to distribution to end-users;
 - (3) The DDB-PDEA Monitoring Team shall have free access to SCAD Service(s) Pte., Ltd. premises where the finished product is kept and/or used;
 - (4) The SCAD Service(s) Pte., Ltd. shall assume full responsibility for any misuse of the imported finished products, caused either by its own negligence or by negligence of all persons acting under their name or control and supervision; and
 - (5) Any violation of the provisions of Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003, shall be a ground for the revocation of the certificate of exemption at anytime and would be dealt with severely.
