BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 56
Series of 2012

SUBJECT: GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM SPECIFIC MEASURES OF REGULATORY CONTROL REQUIREMENTS TO CERTAIN FINISHED PRODUCTS OF WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD.

WHEREAS, under Section 81 (b) and (r) of article IX of RA 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, the Board issued Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003 which provides for the “Comprehensive Guidelines on Importation, Distribution, Manufacture, Prescription, Dispensing and Sale of, and Other Lawful Acts in Connection with any Dangerous Drugs, Controlled Precursors and Essential Chemicals and other Similar or Analogous Substances”;

WHEREAS, WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD. with business address at Block 25 A&B, Phase IV Expansion, Cavite Economic Zone, Rosario, Cavite, Philippines is seeking exemption from regulatory measures for the following products containing controlled chemicals, to wit:

1. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-002 CREAM – 1- 5% Sulfuric acid (H₂SO₄)
2. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-005 DARK GRAY – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
3. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-007 CHAMOIS – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
4. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-009 CAMEL – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
5. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-011 LIGHT PINK – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
6. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-012 LIGHT ORANGE – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
7. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-014 BEIGE – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
8. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-015 ORANGE – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
9. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-016 PINK – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
10. Axis V Black GS30 (Acrylic Resin) – 24% Toluene
11. Acry 8000 Black GS30 (Acrylic Resin) – 22% Toluene
12. Axis V Hardening Agent (Silicon Compound) – 15 – 20% Methyl Ethyl Ketone (MEK)
13. Three Bond 1374 – 0.5% Toluene
14. Chrome Aluminum Paint – 35 – 40% Acetone; 5 – 10% Toluene
15. Spray Paint – 30 -40% Acetone; 1-2% Toluene
16. Stencil Cleaner - T-15 – 9 – 19% Toluene
17. PVC Solvent Cement (SCH 80 Glue) – 1- 30% Methyl Ethyl Ketone (MEK)
18. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-017 LIGHT GRAY – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
19. DELIGHTONE 1 DL-018 GRAY – 1- 5% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)
20. PAINT-073 LINE HIGH ROCK DX (8000 SERIES) - <0.5% Toluene

WHEREAS, Section 4(2-d, e & f), Article III of the same Regulation also provides that the Board may exempt from specific measures of regulatory control requirements any preparation with liquid chemical mixture containing less than 30% by weight of the Table II chemical; or solid, semisolid and highly viscous chemical mixture containing Table II chemical; or when the Board is satisfied that the mixture is formulated in such a way that the controlled chemical cannot be easily used for the illicit manufacture of a dangerous drug and that the controlled chemical or chemicals contained in the mixture cannot be readily recovered;

WHEREAS, to assist the Board in evaluating requests for exemption, it promulgated Board Resolution No.1 Series of 2008 entitled “**Creating a Technical Working Group (TWG) to assist the Board in considering request of Manufacturers and Importers of finished products from specific measures of regulatory control requirements**”;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the DDB Technical Working Group (TWG) that **WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD.** is a company engaged in manufacturing House components exported to Japan. It was established on 14 February 1995. The company started its operation in manufacturing pre-fabricated wooden house parts using computerized pre-cut system. On October 2000, it established its window glass and steel division. The company is duly registered with PDEA and handler of **P5IM-01707001-R027 and P6- 01707001-R024 licenses as importer/end-user and laboratory research. The licenses were issued on 15 June 2011 and valid until July 7, 2012;**

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and evaluation, the TWG decided to recommend to the Board the exemption of **WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD.’** products containing controlled chemical above the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals, after having satisfied the conditions provided in Section 4-2(f);

WHEREAS, after satisfying the requirements stipulated under the above mentioned regulations, **WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD’S products are no longer covered by the provisions of Section 10 (Application for import, export or transit permits) and Section 11 (Grant of import, export or transit permits) of BR No.3, S. 2003.**

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- a. **TO GRANT EXEMPTION to WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD.’S** product that contains controlled chemicals above the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals and the issuance of a Board Resolution for Exemption, which shall be **valid for one (1) year unless revoked.**
- b. That the above cited exemptions shall still be subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) That **WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD.** shall secure a license from the PDEA and comply with the reporting requirements as provided for in Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003;
 - (2) The Board shall strictly monitor subject finished products from their importation to distribution to end-users;
 - (3) The DDB-PDEA Monitoring Team shall have free access to the **WU KONG (S) PTE.LTD.** premises where the finished products are kept and/or used;
 - (4) That **WU KONG (S) PTE. LTD.** shall assume full responsibility for any misuse of the imported finished products, caused either by its own negligence or by negligence of all persons acting under their name or control and supervision; and
 - (5) Any violation of the provisions of Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003, shall be a ground for the revocation of the certificate of exemption at anytime and would be dealt with severely.
