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BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 95
Series of 2012

SUBJECT: GRANTING EXEMPTION FROM SPECIFIC MEASURES OF REGULATORY CONTROL REQUIREMENTS TO CERTAIN FINISHED PRODUCTS OF DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION

WHEREAS, under Section 81 (b) and (r) of Article IX of RA 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, the Board issued Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003 which provides for the “Comprehensive Guidelines on Importation, Distribution, Manufacture, Prescription, Dispensing and Sale of, and Other Lawful Acts in Connection with any Dangerous Drugs, Controlled Precursors and Essential Chemicals and other Similar or Analogous Substances”;

WHEREAS, **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** with business address at Acero Bldg. 891 EDSA, Quezon City, Philippines is seeking exemption from regulatory measures for the following products/reagents containing controlled chemicals:

1. **6323 Hydrochloric Acid 0.1N – 0.4% Hydrochloric Acid (HCL)**
2. **6130 Hydrochloric Acid 0.1N - <4% Hydrochloric Acid (HCL)**
3. **PERACETIC ACID KIT containing Hydrogen Peroxide Titrant with 5 - 10% Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄)**
4. **COD HR(0-15,000 PPM) W/O MERC containing Digestion Reagent #1, 0-1500 ppm with 25 - 30% Sulfuric Acid**
5. **PHOSPHORUS, TOTAL LOW RANGE containing Phosphate Acid Reagent with 5 – 15% Sulfuric Acid; and Total Phosphorous Acid Reagent with Sulfuric Acid, 1.0N (1 -10% Sulfuric Acid)**

WHEREAS, Section 4(2-d, e & f), Article II of the same Regulation also provides that the Board may exempt from specific measures of regulatory control requirements any preparation with liquid chemical mixture containing less than 30% by weight of the Table II chemical; or solid, semisolid and highly viscous chemical mixture containing Table II chemical; or when the Board is satisfied that the mixture is formulated in such a way that the controlled chemical cannot be easily used for the illicit manufacture of a dangerous drug and that the controlled chemical or chemicals contained in the mixture cannot be readily recovered;

WHEREAS, to assist the Board in evaluating requests for exemption, it promulgated Board Resolution No.1 Series of 2008 entitled “**Creating a Technical Working Group (TWG) to assist the Board in considering request of Manufacturers and Importers of finished products from specific measures of regulatory control requirements**”;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the DDB Technical Working Group (TWG) that **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** was organized on February of 1975 as a glasswares and lab chemicals supplier. They are representing about 32 global brands of laboratory products and raised the bar of excellence with their after sales support. This has pushed them to build a **1000 sq. State of the art service testing**

laboratory in 2000 that continued to be ISO 17025 certified to date. The company also offer training and provide Laboratory management solutions to those who wish to become competent and successful in laboratory analysis; share their expertise and give premium value for their services to their partners. Their ambition to attain such status reinforces them to be the Total Laboratory Solutions The company is duly registered with PDEA and handler of P5I-00758001-R030 dated 28 February 2012 and valid until 07 March 2013. Such license was issued as importer/distributor of controlled chemicals;

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and evaluation, the TWG decided to recommend to the Board the exemption of **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** products containing controlled chemical less than the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-2(d);

WHEREAS, after evaluation, the Technical Working Group (TWG) opined that the finished products containing controlled chemicals that are above the 30% threshold of Table II chemicals can be given exemption, due to having satisfied the conditions as provided for in Section 4-2(f);

WHEREAS, after satisfying the requirements under the above mentioned regulations, **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** product is no longer covered by the provisions of **Section 10 (Application for import, export or transit permits)**, **Section 11 (Grant of import, export or transit permits)**, and **Section 22 (Licensed operators NOT to deal with unlicensed operators)** of **BR No.3, S. 2003**.

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- a. **TO GRANT EXEMPTION** and the issuance of a Board Resolution, which shall be valid for one (1) year unless revoked, to **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** product that contains controlled chemical below and above the 30% threshold of the Table II chemicals, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-2(d & f).
- b. That the above cited exemptions shall still be subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) The **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** shall secure a license from the PDEA and comply with the reporting requirements as provided for in Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003;
 - (2) The Board shall strictly monitor subject finished product from their importation to distribution to end-users;
 - (3) The DDB-PDEA Monitoring Team shall have free access to the **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** premises where the finished product is kept and/or used;
 - (4) The **DAKILA TRADING CORPORATION** shall assume full responsibility for any misuse of the imported finished product, caused either by its own negligence or by negligence of all persons acting under their name or control and supervision; and
 - (5) Any violation of the provisions of Board Regulation No. 3, Series of 2003, shall be a ground for the revocation of the certificate of exemption at anytime and would be dealt with severely.
