SUBJECT: APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF PROFESSOR FRANCIS GRACE H. DUKA-PANTE AS DIRECTOR OF THE ASEAN TRAINING CENTER FOR PREVENTIVE DRUG EDUCATION (ATCPDE)

WHEREAS, Paragraph I, Section III (Organization and Structure) of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Dangerous Drugs Board (“Board”) and the University of the Philippines-Diliman (UP-Diliman) dated July 27, 2016, provides that the Director of the ASEAN Training Center for Preventive Drug Education (ATCPDE) shall be appointed by the Board upon recommendation of the University;

WHEREAS, Professor Francis Grace H. Duka-Pante of the UP-Diliman College of Education, was appointed as Director of ATCPDE for a three-year term ending on December 31, 2017 pursuant to Board Resolution No. 65, Series of 2015;

WHEREAS, in a letter to Undersecretary Earl P. Saavedra, DDB Executive Director dated 13 February 2018, Professor Michael L. Tan, Chancellor of UP-Diliman, endorsed the re-appointment of Professor Duka-Pante as Director of ATCPDE for a term of three (3) years.

WHEREAS, due to time constraints, the matter was submitted to the Board Members for approval through *Ad Referendum*.

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the appointment of Professor Francis Grace H. Duka-Pante as Director of the ASEAN Training Center for Preventive Drug Education (ATCPDE) for a term of three (3) years starting from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2020.
