**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 3
Series of 2021**

SUBJECT: APPROVING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF PROFESSOR FRANCIS GRACE H. DUKA-PANTE AS DIRECTOR OF THE ASEAN TRAINING CENTER FOR PREVENTIVE DRUG EDUCATION (ATCPDE)

WHEREAS, Paragraph 1, Section III (Organization and Structure) of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Dangerous Drugs Board (“Board”) and the University of the Philippines-Diliman (UP-Diliman), dated 15 July 2020, provides that the Director of the ATCPDE shall be appointed by the Board upon recommendation of the University;

WHEREAS, Professor FRANCIS GRADE H. DUKA-PANTE of the UP-Diliman College of Education had previously been appointed as Director of the ATCPDE for a three-year term ending on 31 December 2020, pursuant to Board Resolution No. 9, Series of 2018;

WHEREAS, in a letter to the Executive Director of the Board, dated 20 January 2021, UP-Diliman Chancellor FIDEL R. NEMENZO endorsed the reappointment of Professor DUKA-PANTE as Director of the ATCPDE for another term of three (3) years;

WHEREAS, during the 192nd Regular meeting of the Board (6th Special Online Session) held on 4 February 2021, the matter was discussed and was thereafter unanimously approved by the Board.

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the reappointment of Professor FRANCIS GRACE H. DUKA-PANTE as Director of the ATCPDE for a term of three (3) years starting from 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2024.
